

Terms of Reference

Strategy and School Improvement Committee



At least four Governors – to include either the Chair or Vice-chair.

Quorum: 3 members of Committee

Frequency of meetings: at least once per term and as and when required.

School's vision, values and aims.

1. Ensure the development of the school's vision, values and aims.
2. Ensure that the School's Christian ethos and values are reflected in its vision, values and aims.
3. Ensure that there is an effective strategy in place to achieve the school's vision, values and aims.

School Improvement

4. Ensure an integrated approach to the management and development of the school giving due regard to matters of access.
5. Oversee the development, implementation and evaluation of School Improvement Plans.
6. Ensure that there is a rigorous programme of school self-review and receive progress reports.
7. Have oversight of progress on all key issues for action pre and post-Ofsted and Diocesan visits.

Marketing and Communications:

8. Ensure that there are ambitious but realistic marketing and communication strategies in place.
9. Monitor and review the effective implementation of the marketing and communication strategies.
10. Raise a positive school profile and promote the school to all interested parties and stakeholders within the community.

Effective Governance

11. Ensure risks are evaluated, monitored and mitigation plans in place.
12. Ensure a rigorous programme of governance review.
13. Monitor the impact of the governing body.
14. Ensure that the governing body membership has the necessary skills and expertise to execute its duties as a collective body.
15. Ensure appropriate Governor induction, training and professional development is provided.
16. Establish and keep under review arrangements for governors' monitoring visits.
17. Monitor governors' input in school's activities.
18. Review individual governor attendance, involvement and evaluate governor feedback.
