



# Saxilby Church of England School

## Act, Believe, Succeed

### Curriculum Overview

At Saxilby Church of England Primary School, the National Curriculum (2014) is followed by Years 1-6 and the Early Years Statutory Framework for Reception and the Young Explorers unit.

Teachers plan around a topic/theme for a 6 week or 12 week block. The school plans in the following blocks:  
EYFS

Years 1 and 2

Years 3 and 4

Years 5 and 6

Within each of these phases, for English and Maths, children are taught the content for their year group at least once during the year, and

For Science, History, Geography, DT and Art the relevant National Curriculum statements are visited at least once during a two-year rolling programme.

For each topic/theme the phase completes a Medium Term Challenge Planner following a pre-learning task so that children encounter the appropriate skills for their age group and that there is a progression in the learning in and between each phase.

For Computing the school follows the Purple Mash scheme which has year specific units.

For PE the PE leader has developed a scheme of work with a progression of skills based on the PE MAPs document.

For Music the school follows the Music Express scheme with every unit in each phase taught once on a two-year rolling programme.

For Religious Education the school follows the Discovery RE syllabus. All units are taught on a two year rolling programme throughout each phase.

For Modern Foreign Languages at KS2, the school teaches French. The school follows the West Sussex Grid for Learning planning based on mixed classes.
