Rotten Romans



Science

In Science we will be learning about states of matter and grouping materials according to solids, liquids and gases. We will also be setting up experiments to find out about how materials change when they are heated or cooled. Finally, we will be learning about evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

History

In History we will be learning about the Roman Empire and the impact it had on Britain. This will include Roman Invasions, the power of the Roman Army, and the impact of the Romans on the countries beliefs, technology and culture. We will also learn about the British Resistance to Roman invasion.

Music

In Music, we have the privilege of having a music teacher come and teach us Clarinet or Trumpet. These sessions start with Canada Class and will rotate round the classes in Year Three and Year Four in the next few terms. The children will be able to take the musical instruments home to practise. Please keep an eye out for a letter about this within the next week. The rest of the classes will be focusing on skills in composition based on the Romans.

Art

In Art we will be making observations and recording these in sketch books. We will then be using our ideas to create a Roman Tunic with a printed pattern on the front. We will have to use our maths skills to make sure it is symmetrical. We will also have to use special carving tools to create our tile to print.

P.E

In P.E. we will be taking part in both indoor and outdoor sessions. Indoor P.E. for this term is dance. We will be building performances around our topic the Romans. Outdoor skills will focus on passing and receiving. You will need both indoor and outdoor P.E. kits with you each week. Please ask you teacher if you are unsure of the days you are allocated for P.E.

R.E.

In R.E. we are focusing on a strand of Christianity. The unit is Beautiful World, Wonderful God. In this unit, we will be focusing on the world around us and God's place within it. Our value for this term is forgiveness which we will be exploring in class and during collective worship time.
