

Crime and Punishment

Science

In Science we will be learning about the circulatory system, bones and muscles. We will also be setting up experiments to find out about how our pulse rate changes during exercise.

Art

In Art we will be making observations and recording these in sketch books. We will be focusing on shading techniques and line drawings. We will use these skills in our Highwayman art and observational drawings when we visit St Botolphs Church.

History
