We welcome you all to KS1 and hope that you have enjoyed the summer break. We are all very excited about the coming year and have lots of exciting learning planned.

All of the children have completed an assessment in reading and will bring a book home with their reading diary. The children will have a book that is matched to their reading ability and also a reading for pleasure book. It is intended that this is a 'shared' book. It is really important that diaries are brought in everyday so we can let you know when your child has read in school and you can inform us of what reading has happened at home.

Year 1—Outdoor PE on a Thursday, Indoor PE on a Wednesday

Year 2—Outdoor PE on a Monday, Indoor PE on a Wednesday.

However we ask that children leave their PE kits in school during the whole week. Children will have bare feet for indoor PE and will require trainers for outdoor. PE will be taking place outside and we ask that the children have the appropriate clothing in their PE bag. Please could we remind you that long hair must be tied up and that jewellery must not be worn. Please ensure earrings are removed at home if your child is not able to remove them.

Please can we remind all children that they will need a water bottle with their name on which they will need to bring in to school every day.

This term's topic is Change Makers

Year 1

Science:

In Science, the children will be exploring what humans need to survive and how they meet their basic needs.

History:

The children will be looking at the lives of significant individuals including Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale

Art:

The children will know the names of primary colours and how the colour wheel works.

Computing:

The children will be looking at how Information Technology is present in our lives.

RE:

In RE this term the children will be exploring the Christian Faith and exploring the question: What do Christians believe God is like?

Music:

All the learning this term will be focussed around one song (Hey You!). With this song the children will be exploring the dimensions of music through singing and playing linked instruments.

This term's topic is Change Makers

Year 2

Science:

The children will be looking at exercise, healthy diet and what contributes to a healthy functioning body.

History:

The children will be looking at the lives of significant individuals including Martin Luther King Jr and Emily Davison.

Art:

The children will know the names of primary and secondary colours. The children will be investigating how to create secondary colours to use in their artwork.

Computing:

The children will look at how Information Technology is present in our lives.

RE:

In RE this term the children will be exploring the Islamic faith and investigating the key question: What does the Qur'an say about how Muslims should treat each other?

Music:

All the learning this term will be focussed around one song (Hands, Feet, Heart). With this song the children will be exploring the music through singing and playing instruments.
